Transport

- **By plane** the nearest airport is the international Ljubljana Jože Pučnik Airport situated about 23 kilometers north-west of Ljubljana.
- By train Travel by rail is mostly provided by local trains and on some routes also by Eurocity and Intercity (ICS) trains the fastest means of rail transport in Slovenia. Connections between larger cities and towns are regular and quite frequent and the trains are comfortable and air-conditioned. The international connections are also available. Ljubljana is directly connected with Vienna, Graz, Villach and Salzburg in Austria; Sofia in Bulgaria; Prague in the Czech Republic; Solun (Thessaloniki) in Greece; Zagreb, Pula, Opatia and Rijeka in Croatia; Venice in Italy; Budapest in Hungary; Skopje in Macedonia; Munich in Germany; Belgrade in Serbia; and Zurich in Switzerland.
