

About the University

The School of Economics, Law and Medical Sciences (Lipinski University) was founded in 1997. The legal basis for the functioning of the University is the decree of the Ministry of Education № DNS-1-0145-266 / TBM / 97 (entry in the register of non-state higher education institutions and associations of non-state higher education institutions – no. 132).

The School of Economics, Law and Medical Sciences (Lipinski University) is not only the best and the largest private educational institution in the region, but is also among the top universities in the country. Lipinski University has also the largest number of foreign students in the region.

The University ranks high in nationwide papers such as «Polityka», «Wprost», «Newsweek». Our students also run their own newspaper, which is published as a supplement to the most popular newspaper in the region.

The University offers high quality education in 4 main areas: law, economics, medical science and social science.



Tuition cost

Administrative one-time payment of 190 PLN (only for students in the first year of BA level study). Must be paid before 30 September 2016.

Study at a second faculty - free of charge!

On completion of the first year of studies, the University offers free tuition on a second faculty.

Please note

The costs of tuition, as well as accommodation in the city of Kielce is one of the lowest in Poland. The cost of renting student apartments is in the range from 300 to 550 PLN per month, depending on individual needs. Prospective students can take avail of our Summer School of Polish Language and Culture. The cost of participation in the Summer School is 290 PLN per month. This price includes museum tickets and excursions. Tuition, books and materials, participation in cultural activities are all paid by Lipinski University.

The University has a school canteen with prices as low as 10 PLN for the daily menu.

Lipinski University does not charge for: registration for the next semester or year of study, exams, submission and assessment of the diploma thesis, the issuance of the Diploma Supplement.

Required documents:

- 1. The original secondary school certificate or its duplicate bearing the apostille (issued by the ministry of education of the state where it was issued). A copy of the certificate.
- 2. Polish translation of the school certificate with the apostille and other documents in a foreign language, made or certified by:
 - Polish sworn translator registered on the list of sworn translators kept

by the Minister of Justice, or

• Polish consular office in your country.

Only original documents should be submitted for translation, not their scans or photocopies.

- 3. In the event that the certificate does not have a note stating that it entitles you to apply for admission to higher education institutions of every type in your country: certificate confirming that it does entitle you to apply for admission to higher education institutions of every type issued by:
 - the educational authorities of the country by whose education system the certificate was issued, or
 - your country's embassy in Poland, or
 - Polish embassy in your country.

The certificate should include the name, surname, date and place of birth of its holder; the certificate name, number, date and place of issue. The certificate should indicate clearly whether it is a school leaving certificate or matriculation certificate.

- 4. Evidence of the knowledge of the Polish language at intermediate level (unless you wish to enroll for the two-month preparatory course).
- 5. Four 4.5 x 3.5 cm photos signed on the reverse side.
- 6. Color scan of the passport (the page with photo and personal information).
- 7. Completed registration form.
- 8. In the case of applicants to the second or subsequent semester, additionally a copy of the list of subjects and grades obtained at the previous university/ies, also translated into Polish.



Studying and practice abroad

The School of Economics, Law and Health Sciences in Kielce provides students with the opportunity to receive scholarships to study in other countries under the "Erasmus+" programme.

An added benefit of studying at Lipinski University is the opportunity to take the mandatory student work practices and not only in Poland, but also abroad, on the basis of agreements with partner firms. Students studying or taking practice abroad receive additional funding from the funds of the 'Erasmus+" programme in the amount of 300 to 600 EUR per month. The duration of study or practice abroad is from 2 months to 1 year.

The School of Economics, Law and Health Sciences is located in Kielce, a city in south-central Poland with over 200 000 inhabitants. The distance to the capital - Warsaw is 180 km. Today Kielce is a modern city developing dynamically. It is the seat of all the regional authorities of the Świętokrzyskie province. It hosts numerous economic, commercial, scientific and tourist initiatives.

The School of Economics, Law and Health Sciences is located in in the city center, in a complex of modern buildings.
